## Winter Prep Checklist



#### **Home & Heating**

Check & clean fireplace/chimney (sweep, inspect, restock firewood)
 Test smoke & carbon monoxide detectors
 Replace furnace filters & schedule service
 Insulate exposed pipes, seal doors/windows

#### Yard & Garden

- Drain & store hoses and sprinklersCover garden beds with mulch/straw
- Protect trees & shrubs (wrap young trunks, prune branches)
- Store garden tools and clean/lubricate blades

A single 20 lb. bag of ice melt typically covers up to 800 square feet — handy math for driveways, walkways, and decks.



#### **Western Slope Winter Facts**

- Telluride averages 167 inches of snow each year.
- At 8,000 ft., frost depth can reach 36 inches.
- Grand Junction averages just 16 inches of snow, but can dip below 0°F.
- Rural homes are 2x more likely to face long power outages in winter.

# Clean & cover patio furniture and grills Store summer gear (lawnmowers, bikes) Winterize gas/electric equipment (add fuel stabilizer, service snowblowers)

### Organize garage/shed for easy winter access

#### Safety & Emergency

- Prep generators & test backup power
- Check vehicle emergency kits
- Stock up on ice melt, snow shovels, traction products
- Build a winter storm kit: flashlights, blankets, first-aid, water

#### **Seal the Gaps**

Even small cracks around doors and windows can spike heating bills. Weatherstripping and caulk make a big difference.



#### Stock Up Early

Snow shovels and ice melt go fast after the first storm — buy before you need them.



#### **Protect Your Pipes**

Exposed pipes can freeze at 20°F. Insulate outdoor spigots and wrap pipes in unheated areas.



#### **Check Your Detectors**

Test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors when you switch your clocks. Winter heating makes them essential.
